PASTORAL PRAYER:

Grant that we may always cherish and protect the defenseless, supporting them by our strength, and shielding them by our manliness and courage, that through us they may feel the Heavenly Father's care.

O Lord God of Hosts, stretch forth, we pray Thee, thine almighty arm to strengthen and protect the soldiers of our country in every peril; especially shelter them in battle in Viet Nam and keep them safe from all evil.

Eternal God, who hast established the firm foundations of the earth and erected the vaults of the blue, have mercy upon all in our Air Force who fly through the great spaces of the sky. Uphold them with thy saving grace and give them the assurance of thy protection.

O God, who art the confidence of all who dwell upon the earth and of them that are afar off upon the sea, safeguard the lives of our sailors as they defend our country on the oceans and maintain the justice and freedom of the nations. Keep them strong in faith, in courage, and in self-control.

Almighty God, Lord of the nations: direct all those who govern us; bless our Commander-In-Chief President Johnson, and those with authority in every land, that they may be led by thy wisdom, and rule with justice and mercy.
