Many times we are not willing to face our faults and confess our sins. Lord, we now admit our guilt before you. Father, we have done wrong; by not caring when we should have loved; by our indifference to the cry of need; and by hating and ignoring our neighbors. We have rejected the way of your Son, and no longer deserve to be called your children.
