5. The world's ills are not in poor politics, bad government, or mechanized civilization but in the heart of men.
6. Man himself needs to be changed.

## II. The Nature of the disease.

1. A stony heart. Ezek. 11:19  
A hardened heart  
(hardening of the arteries)
2. A faint heart -- Jer. 8:18; Lam. 1:22  
weak
3. Deceitful heart. Jer. 14:14  
(Apparently healthy, but a bad heart)
4. A murmuring heart.  
Jer. 4:19, "my heart maketh a noise."  
A. Complaining, grumbling  
B. Pang of conscience  
"my heart is pained"

## III. The Cure for the Disease.

1. Only God can cure the disease.
  - A. Not penicillin, cortisone, or digitalis tablets.
  - B. Divine therapy needed.
2. Electrocardiogram of God's Word.
3. Diagnosis of the Holy Spirit.
4. Prescription and treatment of the Lord Jesus Christ.
5. Cooperation of the patient. (over)
